



STEPHEN WANHILL is the Editor of *Tourism Economics*, and Adjunct Professor of Tourism Economics, University of Limerick and Emeritus Professor of Tourism Research, Bournemouth University. He is a Director of Global Tourism Solutions (UK) and his principal research interests are in the field of tourism destinations. To this extent he has undertaken a wide range of tourism development and tourism impact assessments, with an emphasis project studies from airports to attractions, both in the UK and worldwide, covering some 50 countries. He has acted as tourism policy advisor to the UK Parliamentary Select Committee on Welsh Affairs for a period of five years, and has been a Board Member of the Wales Tourist Board with responsibilities for the development and research divisions. In this capacity, he spent much time reviewing and recommending grant applications for projects that encompass accommodation, restaurants and pubs, attractions and public facilities, such as country parks, visitor centres and infrastructure improvements, as well as contributing to the rolling 5-year Development Plan of the Board.
